CISCO Certified Network Associate (CCNA)

The CCNA program prepares students for career opportunities and the CCNA certification exam by teaching the basics of routing, switching and advanced technologies. The CCNA is recognized in the industry as a technical professional working with traditional Cisco-based networks that include LAN and WAN routers and LAN switches.

Microsoft Technology Associate Certification: Networking Fundamentals

Networking Fundamentals is an entry level certification for a fundamental understanding of networking concepts in a Windows Server 2008 environment such as network infrastructures, network hardware, and protocols and services. MTA Certifications will provide the foundational knowledge required to begin building an IT career by using Microsoft technologies.

CompTIA A+ Certification

The CompTIA A+ program is the starting point for an IT career. This certification prepares students to begin their career with learning PC installation, hardware configuration, and troubleshooting with a strong emphasis on Customer Service. The opportunities for advancement and alternate fields are virtually endless.

CompTIA Security+ Certification Training

The CompTIA Security+ program prepares students to apply knowledge of security concepts, tools, and procedures to react to security incidents and they will learn to administer access control and identify management and apply cryptography.

Information Technology Support Specialist

This certificate prepares students for employment as a microcomputer support specialist, help desk specialist, user support analyst, customer service representative, computer operator, computer repair technician, computer sales person, software tester, or user support specialist.
